The European Venture Contest, now in its 12th edition, entails a series of over 15 annual region and sector-focused venture forums culminating in the continent's biggest venture marketplace, the EVS, uniting 120 award winning entrepreneurs and over 120 venture capital and corporate investors. The contest attracts over 1000 applications from emerging companies (typically seed to series A) every year, which are reviewed and rated by around 400 participating investors. Around 500 selected companies pitch at the different venture forums and the top quartile is then united at the EVS with the European VC and corporate innovation community.

Over the past decade, the EVS has earned itself quite the reputation for uniting over 100 movers and shakers of the European VC and CVC community in a spirit of collaboration to learn, engage and connect. Moreover, the EVS has a great track record of facilitating deals, with over \$661 million raised by companies presenting in the last five years.

I would like to extend my particular gratitude this year to the NRW Ministries of Innovation, Science & Research and Economy, Energy, Industry & Crafts as well as Orrick (law firm), the NRW Bank, the City of Düsseldorf, the Chamber of Commerce of Cologne and Biocampus Cologne for pulling together the resources to bring us all together.

Herewith, I would like to invite you to join us at the 10th edition of the EVS taking place from the 5-6 December in Düsseldorf Congress - CCD Sud, uniting both founders and funders for a two-day pitching, networking and idea-sharing spree.
