Seven Balkan companies taking part in prestigious European Venture Summit in Düsseldorf on December 9 & 10, 2013.

Brussels, November 26, 2013 – Seven entrepreneurs from the Balkan region will be travelling to Düsseldorf this December to take part in the <u>European Venture Summit</u>. The Summit, is one of Europe's largest two-day gatherings of Europe's most promising high-tech companies, venture capital investors and corporate technology scouts.

Contrary to most industry events, the Summit is dedicated specifically to allow technology entrepreneurs to network in person with large corporate professionals and venture capital investors. The event's dynamic program caters to this need and allows for easy networking among representatives of over 200 large and small companies.

Each of these seven Balkan businesses was selected as an Award winner at one of the regional qualifiers of the *European Venture Contest*. These events, the Balkan Venture Forums in Sofia (May 21 & 22) and Tirana (November 14 & 15), allowed entrepreneurs from the Balkan peninsula a direct road to meeting international business contacts. The Forums target entrepreneurs with a scalable technology concept and the drive to grow their business internationally.
