Brussels, August 7, 2013 –After the successful Balkan Venture Forum in Sofia; showcasing 37 innovative, ICT start-ups, the 4th edition of the Forum is announced to take place on **14-15 November 2013**. This time the capital city of **Albania; Tirana**, will be the location promoting innovation and entrepreneurship in the Balkan region.
